Note to the Summary Combined Financial Statements December 31, 2024

The summary combined financial statements are derived from the audited combined financial statements, prepared in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations, as at December 31, 2024 and December 31, 2023 and for the years then ended.

The preparation of these summary combined financial statements requires management to determine the information that needs to be included to ensure they are consistent in all material respects with, or represent a fair summary of, the audited combined financial statements.

Management prepared these summary combined financial statements using the following criteria:

- (a) These summary combined financial statements include the assets, liabilities, net assets and operating activities of The Canadian Civil Liberties Association and The Canadian Civil Liberties Education Trust. Summary combined financial statements are presented because of the common control of The Canadian Civil Liberties Association and The Canadian Civil Liberties Education Trust. All intercompany balances and transactions have been eliminated.
- (b) The summary combined financial statements include a statement for each statement in the audited combined financial statements, except the combined statement of changes in net assets and combined statement of cash flows, which can be obtained from the complete set of audited combined financial statements;
- (c) Information in the summary combined financial statements agrees with the related information in the audited combined financial statements;
- (d) Major subtotals, totals and comparative information from the audited combined financial statements are included; and
- (e) The summary combined financial statements contain the information from the audited combined financial statement dealing with matters having pervasive or otherwise significant effect on the summary combined financial statements.
